Sam wondered about the frequency of the Film Night – should it be monthly? Jonathan wondered if that puts a load on the few people with enough room. Sally and Jonathan will do the next one. It was agreed that the hosts should be the ones to choose the film they show.

Sally wondered about having board-game evenings.

Jonathan passed round a notice for rules of what should go on the boards and will post that on both boards.

Welcome pack: Liz can no longer do this so we need another person to update and deliver it. Sam suggested making this a standing item on the VRG agenda.
